## **CORNERSTONE POOL RULES**

- 1. For use by Cornerstone residents ONLY! A Cornerstone resident must accompany any guests (*maximum number of guests is 2 per household*) and resident must be current in assessments.
- 2. ALL SWIMMING IS AT YOUR OWN RISK. NO LIFEGUARD WILL BE PROVIDED.
- 3. Pool hours are 5:00 am to 10:00 pm during swim season, except when closed for maintenance. Both pool gates will automatically lock at 10:00 pm. DO NOT CLIMB OVER GATES OR FENCES!
- 4. Children under the age of 15 are not allowed in the pool area without adult supervision.
- 5. Diving, running, loud music, offensive language, inappropriate behavior, horseplay, alcohol or tobacco usage, or any other activity that interferes with the enjoyment of others shall be grounds for loss of pool privileges for the year. No glass containers of any kind in the pool area.
- 6. Risky behavior increases liability of all Cornerstone residents. Residents who witness this type of activity should try to control this behavior to the greatest extent possible.
- 7. Proper swim wear is required in the pool area. Jeans, thongs, speedo's or the like are prohibited. Only swim diapers are permitted.
- 8. Items such as balloons, or the like, are prohibited in pool area, as they can cause blocking or plugging of the pool lines and equipment.
- 9. Residents should remove all trash and restore the pool area, including bathrooms, before leaving.
- 10. Remove all personal items (floats, towels, rafts, goggles, etc.) when leaving the pool area. CHOA is not responsible for any items left behind.
- 11. The entrance gates should be kept closed at all times.
- 12. If someone cannot get into the pool area and asks to be let in, do not allow them access. Tell them to call Specialty Management. They may not be a resident at all.
- 13. No skateboards, heelys, scooters, bicycles, rollerblades, or the like are permitted around the pool or in pool area.
- 14. Any of the above violations could result in termination of pool privileges.
