CORNERSTONE FISHING RULES

(REVISED October 2018)

- 1. CORNERSTONE RESIDENTS ONLY!
- 2. Guests must be accompanied by a CHOA member at all times.
- 3. Anyone using Cornerstone facilities not in the presence of a Cornerstone resident is trespassing.
- 4. Only 2 guests per CHOA member.
- 5. Fishing is allowed in all common areas but not within 50 feet of lot line.
- 6. Fish at your own risk.
- 7. No swimming in lake.
- 8. Children under the age of 15 are required to have adult supervision.
- 9. Limits are as follows:
 - i. Bass 3 per day, 14" & under.
 - ii. ALL Bass over 14" must be released.
 - iii. Bream 20 per day
 - iv. Catfish take all out.
 - v. Crappie take all out.
 - vi. Grass Carp leave in lakes.
- 10. No littering. Please take out your trash.
- 11. Members only boats allowed.
- 12. Loud music, offensive language, inappropriate behavior, horseplay, glass bottle usage, alcohol or tobacco usage, or any other activity that interferes with the enjoyment of others shall be grounds for loss of fishing privileges
- 13. Risky behavior increases the liability of all Cornerstone residents. Residents who witness this type of activity should try to control this behavior to the greatest extent possible.
- 14. Electric-powered motors only.
- 15. Fishing licenses are required by the State of Mississippi.
- 16. No ATV's or vehicles on dam.
